When might we need an emergency director's meeting?

- Due to an unforeseen circumstance where an urgent authoritative decision is needed.
- As part of our complaints procedure.

When someone makes a formal complaint there is the opportunity to attend a complaints meeting. The aim of this meeting will be to find voluntary, negotiated resolutions.

If agreements cannot be negotiated in this way, and there is need for an authoritative decision, there is the option of bringing the complaint to an Emergency Directors' Meeting.

Who can attend an emergency director's meeting?

- Members

Will it be a closed meeting?

- Yes. The door will be locked from when the meeting starts.

How can someone know that an emergency directors meeting is happening?

- By agreeing to have their name on a group text/phone call list.
- By seeing a notice that will go up in the Bridge Collective
