The Bridge Collective is looking to recruit a community development worker with a focus on developing community through the vehicle of speaking about personal experience of mental health issues. Understanding of, and commitment to collective working and consensus decision making is essential to the role.

Bridge Collective Mission Statement

To be a company whose members are creating: A democratic community where people who have experiences, beliefs, and feelings that have sometimes been labeled as mental illness are welcomed and can talk about these experiences freely, safely and without judgment; a place to participate in friendship, support, learning, teaching, discussion, being active, and making a valid contribution both within the collective and the wider community.

Hours: 9 hrs/wk. Experts by Experience work currently takes place on variable week days depending on workshop timetabling. Experts by Experience meetings are the 1st & 3rd Tuesday of the month 11am-1pm. Other meetings, training, events occur on different days. Essential training will take place on variable days in October.

Pay: £10.30 per hour. Based in central Exeter, this role includes public transport travel to venues over Devon. This post is funded on a financial year annual review basis. An enhanced DBS check (Disclosure and Barring Service) is required for this role.
